## KBoD Elections

It is time for the annual KLOUDBusters Board of Directors (KBoD) election. We are electing the 2011 Prefect for 1 year, and Vice-President, Secretary, and (1) Member-at-Large for two-year terms for 2011-2012.

Per the KLOUDBusters By-Laws: "*The official and monetary matters of the Corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors.*" In other words, the KBoD makes policy, sets schedules, and spends the money. We have a slate of great candidates willing and able to take on these responsibilities for the Club.

Enclosed with this newsletter is a postage-paid ballot for this election. The deadline for ballot receipt is December 31, 2010. The bios for each of the candidates follow:

### **Prefect** (1 year term)

**Bob Brown** Hi! I'm Bob Brown and I am a candidate for Prefect. I have been involved with high-powered rocketry since 1998 and am the current Prefect seeking re-election. I've been involved with the club since that time and have held one position or another on the Kloubusters board since 2000. Thank you in advance for your vote.
